

## PLUMBER LEADER

NATURE OF WORK IN THIS CLASS:

Leads a crew and performs skilled work in the installation, alteration and maintenance of plumbing systems, fittings and accessories.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK: (These examples do not list all the duties which may be assigned; any one position may not include all the duties listed).

Leads a plumbing crew in the layout, installation, maintenance and repair of a variety of plumbing fixtures and required lines; inspects equipment to be repaired and instructs subordinates to repair or replace parts as needed; works from sketches, drawings and piping diagrams; makes corrections to field prints to indicate work accomplished.

Maintains records of time charged to projects; makes cost estimates for projects; prepares reports as required.

Insures that materials and equipment are properly maintained and that replacement parts are available.

Demonstrates work methods and procedures, proper use of tools and equipment and safety practices to subordinates.

Performs related duties as required.

MINIMUM KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

Knowledge of the standard methods, materials, practices and equipment used in the installation, alteration and maintenance of plumbing systems, fittings and accessories.

Knowledge of local plumbing codes.

Ability to lead the work of others.

Ability to read, interpret and work directly from sketches, drawings and piping diagrams.

Ability to make cost estimates on work projects.

Ability to perform arduous physical tasks including heavy lifting and working in strained and awkward positions.

Ability to follow and provide oral and written instructions.

Ability to apply and enforce safe work practices on the job.


Skill in the plumbing trade.

MINIMUM EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

(a) Five years of experience in the installation, alteration, and maintenance of plumbing systems, fixtures and accessories, including one year at the skilled level; or

(b) Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the minimum knowledge, abilities and skills.
