

HIGHWAY SIGN LEADER

NATURE OF WORK IN THIS CLASS:

Leads a crew and performs skilled work in the fabrication, installation and repair of highway signs, striping of highways, and the painting of guardrails, bridges and related structures.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK: (These examples do not list all the duties which may be assigned; any one position may not include all the duties listed).

Leads a crew and performs work in the fabrication and repair of highway signs, the striping of highways and the painting of guardrails, bridges and related structures.

Ensures that highway signs, striping of highways and painting of guardrails, bridges and related structures are in accordance with traffic codes, rules and regulations.

Estimates the time and materials needed for work projects; ensures that materials and equipment are properly maintained and that replacements are available.

Interprets and works from manuals, sketches and blueprints.

Applies and enforces safe work practices on the job.

Maintains records and prepares reports.

Performs related duties as required.

MINIMUM KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

Knowledge of the methods, practices, techniques, tools and equipment used in the fabrication and installation of traffic signs and painting of highway and related structures.

Knowledge of traffic codes, rules and regulations pertaining to traffic signs.

Ability to lead the work of others.

Ability to estimate the time and materials needed for work projects.

Ability to interpret and work from manuals, sketches and blueprints.

Ability to apply and enforce safe work practices on the job.

Ability to work effectively with the public and employees.

Ability to follow and provide oral and written instructions.

Skill in the fabrication and installation of highway signs, striping of highways and painting of guardrails, bridges and related structures.

MINIMUM EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

(a) Three years of experience involved in the fabrication and installation of highway signs, painting and striping of highways, guardrails, bridges and related structures, including one year at the skilled level.

(b) Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the minimum knowledge, abilities and skills.
