### Who Can Apply

Open to all government of Guam employees and the public.

### Qualification Requirements

Graduation from a recognized college or university with a Bachelor's degree in microbiology, biology or related field.

### Nature of work

This is routine professional microbiologic laboratory work. Employees in this class perform routine professional laboratory duties independently after initial training and work under closer supervision on a variety of more complex development assignments.

### Illustrative Examples of Work

Assists in performing standard routine microbiologic and similar laboratory tests, using basic laboratory equipment on various specimens in order to establish the presence and identification of infectious disease agents. Assists in preparing specimens of water, blood, body fluids, or other materials for examination by culture or other standard laboratory diagnostic techniques. Assists in preparing and checking specimens, solutions, reagents, and other materials necessary for conducting tests. Prepares and stains slides for microscopic study; makes cultures of microorganisms for study and identification. Maintains records and prepares reports of findings of Laboratory tests. May participate in investigation and laboratory research work. May assist in training less experienced laboratory workers. Performs related duties as required.

### Knowledge, Abilities & Skills

Knowledge of microbiology, general biological science, and related phase of chemistry and physics. Knowledge of standard laboratory methods, procedures and equipment. Ability to perform a variety of standard microbiologic and laboratory analyses and tests. Ability to apply microbiologic and biologic principles and practices to problems in laboratory work and arrive at workable solutions. Ability to work effectively with the public and employees. Ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing. Ability to maintain records and prepare reports. Ability to apply and enforce safe work practices. Skill in the use of laboratory equipment.

### Minimum Educational Requirements

All new employment in the service of the government of Guam shall have, as a reasonable measure of job performance, minimum requirement of a high school diploma or a successful completion of General Education Development (GED) test or any equivalent of a general education high school program, apprenticeship program or successful completion of a certification program, from a recognized, accredited or certified vocational technical institution, in a specialized field required for the job, pursuant to Public Law 29-113.

### Documentation Requirements

To validate credentials you may claim, (e.g., High School Diploma, College Transcript, DD-214, etc.), an original or certified copy of the document(s) must accompany each employment application you are applying for with your legal signature. Applicants shall be responsible to provide all required documents for each employment application submitted and failure to provide proof may result in disqualification. **For more information, please contact the Recruitment Branch at 475-1141/1128/1271.**

### Suitability Determination Form

Your employment application will not be deemed completed unless the Suitability Determination Form is completely filled out, signed and dated. If it is not complete or missing from your application, your application for this position will be rejected. Please pay particular attention to question #2. If you answer "yes", you must attach your police clearance that is no older than one (1) month from the date of submitting your application. In addition, please resubmit an updated Suitability form if anything occurred that warrants updating your responses on your Suitability Form after you have submitted your application.

**MICROBIOLOGIST I  
OPEN COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION**

**Prohibition Pursuant to P.L. 28-98**

No person convicted of a sex offense under the provision of chapter 25 of Title 9 GCA, or an offense as defined in Article 2 of Chapter 28, Title 9 GCA in Guam, or an offense in any jurisdiction which includes, at a minimum, all of the elements of said offenses, or who is listed on the Sex Offender Registry shall work in any agency or instrumentality of the government of Guam.

**Examination Requirements**

Applicants will be rated on a scale between 70.00 and 100.00 percent on the basis of their training, education and experience in relation to the requirements of the position.

**Interviewing Procedures**

A personal interview or interview by telephone (if off-island) will be held by the appointing authority or his designee for all eligibles referred via certification.

**Employment Medical Examination**

All applicants accepting employment must undergo a medical examination and be declared by the physician as capable of performing the duties of the position being hired for.

**Work Eligibility**

When offered a position, you will be required to provide proof of identity and eligibility for employment in the United States as condition of employment.

**Drug Screening**

Applicants selected for and offered employment with the Government of Guam shall undergo and pass a mandatory drug test before being employed; this also applies to employees selected for Test Designated Positions (TDP). Failure to submit or pass such drug test shall be grounds for rescinding the offer of appointment. In addition, persons who have applied for, or are seeking reemployment/reappointment in the government and previously had a non-negative drug test result must meet certain conditions to be re-drug tested for employment. **Police & Court Clearances Requirements**

If selected for this position, your selection will be **conditional** pending submission of a recent police and court clearance, and taking and passing a drug test (see Drug Screening section of the announcement). The hiring department will mail a letter to you explaining these requirements. You will have five (5) business days from the postmarked date of your letter to submit police and court clearances that are no older than one (1) month from the date of your letter. The cost of the clearances is your responsibility. If you have already submitted clearances with your employment application, you will not be required to resubmit as long as they meet the date criteria above. If you do not have any conviction or conditions that would warrant rescinding the job offer, and pass the drug test you will be notified of your start date.
